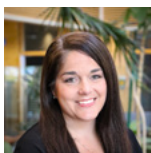

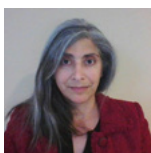
## Education Session Speakers

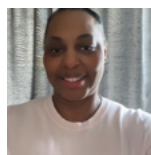
