- In-kind contributions (30%, max \$3750)


Research Mentor

- Co-develop and oversee learning plan
- Guide and support RPN across all research related activities

RPN Research Fellow



- Executive sponsor to oversee and enable **RPN** research participation
- CNO registration in good standing
- Employed directly or indirectly in the delivery of patient/client care
- Explore or address a clinical or professional issue *note: PN students are not eligible
