

Information for Candidates

Research Advisory Council (RAC)

RAC provides input and guidance to support WeRPNs growing work to enhance RPN focused research. The multi-member council is made up of RPN, Academic and Public representatives alongside WeRPN Leaders.

Meeting Frequency

Members will serve for a term of two (2) years with acceptance of subsequent terms. Virtual meetings occur minimally on a quarterly basis (October, January, April, July). Members are encouraged in-person attendance to support the annual research symposium knowledge exchange event.

Additional Responsibilities

- Monitoring trends and issues for RPNs to identify new knowledge, information or gaps.
- Review and provide feedback on external research requests, proposal submissions, and knowledge mobilization activities.
- Provide recommendations to WeRPN regarding research and research initiatives, including achieving WeRPNs research priorities and strategic goals.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Reside in Ontario, Canada
- Be an RPN in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario, **or** educator/researcher, **or** worked closely with RPNs, **or** patient/care partner where RPN care was provided.
- Knowledge of the nursing profession, and the RPN category of nursing within the health system

Statement of Interest to Join RAC

Your statement of interest should highlight the skills that prepare you to contribute to supporting RPN research. In 1-2 pages,

- include your name and contact information
- state position you are interested in
- illustrate your experience and interests relevant to RPN research
- demonstrate the skills and strengths that you would bring to the RAC if you were the successful candidate, and
- demonstrate your understanding of RPNs and the importance of driving evidence

**WeRPN membership/associate membership is not required; however, applications from members will be prioritized*
